

Dress Code

We kindly ask that you review our dress policy and communicate these guidelines to your guests to ensure a seamless experience.

CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE GUIDELINES

Gentlemen and Young Men:

Collared dress shirts, polo-style shirts, Henley-style shirts, dress slacks, dress shorts, or sweaters. Collared shirts are preferred.

Camp or Henley shirts (designed to be untucked or without a collar) are permitted in the clubhouse but not on the golf course or practice facilities.

Ladies and Girls:

Dresses, blouses, dress tops, collarless dress shirts, polo-style shirts, sweaters, dress slacks, or dress shorts.

Prohibited Attire in the Clubhouse

Ripped, soiled, stained, frayed, or cut-off garments

Bare midriff or see-through clothing (applies to men and women)

Camouflage clothing or accessories

Shorts with an inseam shorter than six inches

Skater shorts that fall below the knee

Coveralls, t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, tank/halter tops, gym attire, or spandex clothing

Swimsuits or cover-ups

Denim that is ripped, frayed, or in disrepair (even if purchased in this condition)

Hat Policy

Hats are not permitted inside the clubhouse at any time. Gentlemen are required to remove their hats in all clubhouse areas. When worn outdoors (parking lots /patios), hats must be forward-facing and with appropriate designs. Ladies dress/formal hats are permissible if appropriate.
